Welcome to everyone as you return to school, or start for the first time, this September. We look forward to working with you to enable your child to be the best they can be.

## Come in and meet the teacher!

We will be running 'Meet The Teacher' sessions again this year. These will be held on **Wednesday, 13th September**. The meetings will be for parents with children from Year 1 to Year 6 and are designed for you to get to meet the teacher very early on in the term and for the teacher to be able to give you key information that will help everyone through the year. It is not a 'parents evening' private meeting, but an open meeting for all parents and the children in that class, to listen to the teacher's key messages for the year. Amongst other things, you will find out more about the academic expectation for the year group and what you can do at home to support your child's learning. Teachers will run two meetings back-to-back. The first will start at 3.30pm and the next will start at 4.15pm. This allows parents with children in two classes to meet both teachers. You do not need to book in at all, just turn up to the one you want to. For classes where there is a job share, both teachers will be present. For siblings in a different class to the one you are going to, there will be a film on in the school hall, supervised by me, for them to watch.

Reception parents will be having an individual appointment with their teacher in the first week.

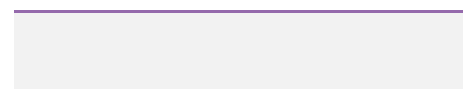
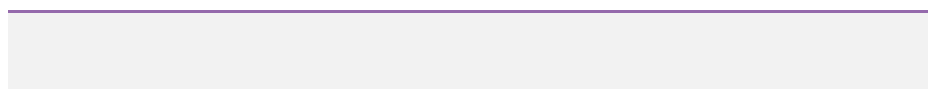
## Breakfast Club
